Deputy Juvenile Correctional Officers (DJCOs) assigned to the Youth Guidance Center (YGC) will ensure that all

A. NIGHT SECURITY CHECK

The P.M. Center 1 or Duty Officer (D.O.) will ensure that all exterior doors and windows of ground floor buildings are secured

B. FRONT GATE SECURITY

Communication to the visitor at the gate is via telephone through the speaker box located at the gate. When the visitor presses the call button, the system

front office answer the phone and speak to the visitor. They monitor the gate

 Problems with the gate are to be called in to Orange County Public Works Facilities Operations during their regular work hours from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. They will contact the current contractor.

II. NIGHT SECURITY CHECK PROCEDURE

D.O. or designated staff will secure facility in the following order:



- Q. Make note of perimeter lights not working and submit maintenance request form.
- R. While on perimeter check, make note of any graffiti along freeway underpass and surrounding walls.
