SUICIDE PREVENTION

AUTHORITY: Administrative Directive

RESCINDS: Procedure Manual Item 1-4-003, dated 08/28/15

FORMS: None

PURPOSE: To offer guidance for action upon receiving a telephone report of attempted

suicide or suicidal ideations.

GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Any Probation Department employee is authorized to notify law enforcement agencies in an emergency wherein a person threatens self-injury, suicide or injury to others.

B. Each call from a person who attempts or threatens suicide is unique and should be taken as credible. Local law enforcement agencies will cooperate upon receiving a request for assistance.

II. PROCEDURE

- A. Obtain from the person calling the following information:
 - 1. Name of person calling.
 - 2. Name of person **making threats of suicide or** attempting to commit suicide.
 - 3. Address where the incident is occurring.
 - 4. How the person is attempting to take **their** (pills, knife, gun, etc.).
- B. Immediately ask a co-worker to relay the above information to the **law enforcement agency** having jurisdiction by calling 911.

C. Suggestions:

- 1. If the caller is **making threats of or** attempting suicide, make an effort to engage the caller in conversation. Your interest in the caller may save **their** life.
- 2. Request the assistance of a co-worker. The co-worker can locate files, call police, etc.
- 3. The caller's name, address and telephone number might be obtained from the caller's probation file.

- 4. Given a telephone number, **911** can obtain the address where the telephone is located.
- 5. If the suicide attempt involves an adult or youth on probation, notify the deputy probation officer <u>after</u> contact has been made with law enforcement authorities.
- 6. Inform your immediate supervisor as soon as safely possible.
