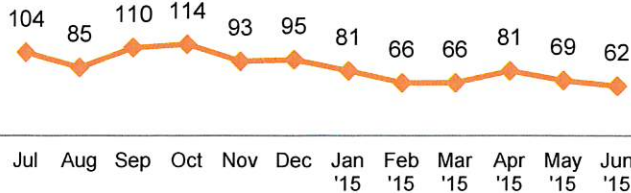

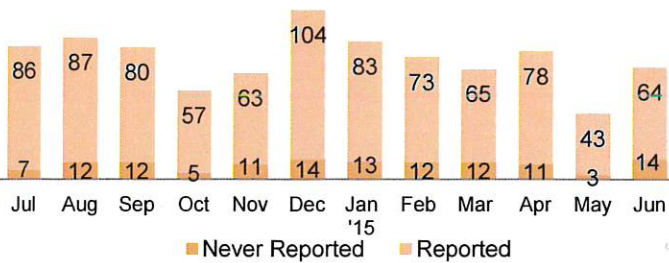

36.34% of individuals had at least one warrant issued since 10/1/2011.

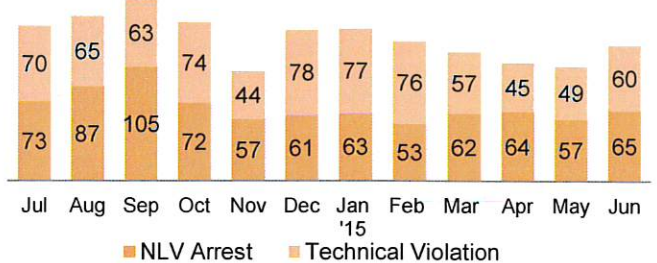


Revocations

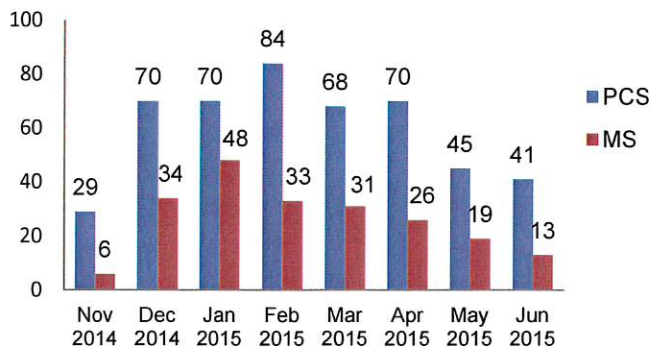

Mandatory Supervision (MS)

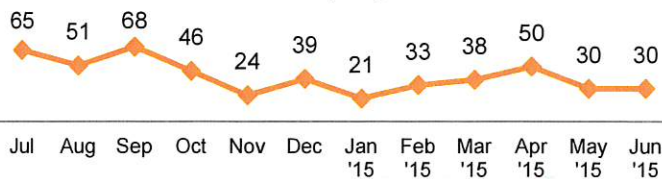
